

Lindisfarne College of Theology is pleased to announce a new pathway for postgraduate study specifically designed to fit the work and needs of lay and ordained ministers:

Postgraduate Certificate - Ministerial Development Pathway

Our Postgraduate Certificate is a 60-credit programme, validated by Durham University, and usually done part-time over 1 year. We offer students a range of options between taught modules and supervised independent research. (After completing the PG Cert, students may also progress to a PG Diploma or MA.)

In recognising that it is sometimes difficult for those in ministry to find the space even for part-time study, students on this new pathway will be given 2 years to complete the certificate without any additional cost. Some of the key benefits include:

- More choices among modules. LCT offers different modules on a year-to-year basis, so students doing the Postgraduate Certificate over 2 years will have twice as many options for modules in addition to the option for supervised independent research.
- **Flexibility.** The 2-year pathway allows students more flexibility to schedule their studies around their work; students with church responsibilities can more easily avoid clashes between assignment deadlines and demanding stretches of the church calendar.
- **Cost Effectiveness.** While students are normally required to pay a registration fee for each academic year, students admitted to the Ministerial Development Pathway for the Postgraduate Certificate will only be required to pay the registration fee for 1 year.

Over the 2024-25 Academic year, postgraduate students on this pathway will be able to take modules such as: *Christian Faith and the Environment, Advanced Topic in Old Testament: Reading Isaiah Today, Theologies of the Majority World: Sub-Saharan Africa and India,* and *Mission and Apologetics.* For postgraduate students who want to undertake an independent research project, we have a deep roster of experienced supervisors with expertise in church planting, the Christian tradition, spiritual practice, Biblical interpretation, questions concerning the Northeast Church, and much more.

Our **Ministerial Development Pathway** for the **Postgraduate Certificate** is currently being offered at a set cost of £1850. This includes the registration fee and can be paid in 4 installments over 2 years. Flexible payment plans are also available, and we encourage you to speak to your CMD officer about sources for funding. Please note that prospective students will need to demonstrate that they are ordained or licensed lay ministers to apply for this pathway.
